



about 130 of them were Jews.









When the Freuds arrived in Vienna, they moved to the traditional Jewish district, Leopoldstadt. It had once been Vienna's ghetto. Nearly half of the <u>15,000 Jews</u> living in Vienna around 1860 clustered in the district.








